



**Historical SE Geysers Effluent Pipeline Deliveries to The Geysers






Southeast Geysers Seismic Study Area


SEISMIC EVENTS

- Magnitude 3.0 & greater




**The Geysers (KGRA) - Historical Seismic Activity

Summary

South East Geysers, Oct 1, 2015 – March 31, 2016

- Average SEGEP injection – 6.1 million GPD
- The pipeline has been in continuous operation following an 18 day outage due to the Valley Fire at the end of the previous period.
- Water injection is down approximately 14% from the previous 6 months.
- Seismic activity is up approximately 20% from the previous 6 months.
 - 79 seismic events during the last 6 months magnitude 1.5 or greater, compared to 66 events the previous 6 months
 - No seismic events with magnitude 3.0 or greater
